Our Model

The **Coalfields Regeneration Trust** is a community wealth building charity with a successful track record of delivering impactful regeneration work since 1999.

Scotland's coalfields cover a large geographic area and have a combined population of approximately 554,000 people.

In order to maximise our impact, we focus our charitable activities on the 30% most deprived communities using the Index of Multiple Deprivation.



Through Scottish Government funding we deliver programmes in Scotland's Coalfields communities that address our 5 missions of community, health, skills, jobs and climate.



Our property development subsidiary **CRT Property** builds industrial units for SMEs – creating jobs and economic growth in coalfield communities.

CRT Property's taxable profits are re-invested through the **Coalfields Regeneration Trust** charity and our partners into tackling social and economic challenges in local communities.

We want to roll out our successful model of building industrial units for SMEs to create jobs and economic growth in Scotland's coalfield communities.

The needs in Dunfermline

11.14% of children 19 and under are in absolute low-income families

1 in 17 people are in bad or very bad health.

There are only 62 jobs per 100.

1 in 105 claim DLA.

1 in 7 people have no qualifications.

Of those aged 16-64, 19.01% claim DWP benefits.

CRT activities in Dunfermline

We continue to support communities across West Fife through a strong programme of Local Place Planning, action planning and skills development. In Blairhall, our team has been delivering ongoing community engagement and development work as part of wider action-planning activity aimed at strengthening local capacity and addressing identified community priorities. In Kincardine, we have worked closely with the Community Council, local partners and residents to produce and launch the Kincardine Local Place Plan, supporting consultation, design, and alignment with wider regeneration and climate-focused initiatives, including work with RSPB Climate FORTH partners. Alongside this, our Training and Enterprise Hub in Kincardine continues to deliver a range of skills and accredited training courses that benefit people from surrounding villages, contributing to improved wellbeing, employability and community resilience.
