Our Model

The **Coalfields Regeneration Trust** is a community wealth building charity with a successful track record of delivering impactful regeneration work since 1999.

Scotland's coalfields cover a large geographic area and have a combined population of approximately 554,000 people.

In order to maximise our impact, we focus our charitable activities on the 30% most deprived communities using the Index of Multiple Deprivation.



Through Scottish Government funding we deliver programmes in Scotland's Coalfields communities that address our 5 missions of community, health, skills, jobs and climate.



Our property development subsidiary **CRT Property** builds industrial units for SMEs – creating jobs and economic growth in coalfield communities.

CRT Property's taxable profits are re-invested through the **Coalfields Regeneration Trust** charity and our partners into tackling social and economic challenges in local communities.

We want to roll out our successful model of building industrial units for SMEs to create jobs and economic growth in Scotland's coalfield communities.

The needs in Stirling

12.15% of children 19 and under are in absolute low-income families.

1 in 17 people are in bad or very bad health.

There are only 86 jobs per 100.

1 in 88 claim DLA.

1 in 7 people have no qualifications.

Of those aged 16-64, 18.07% claim DWP benefits.

CRT activities in Stirling

We deliver CRT Game On activities in Fallin, within the Stirling constituency, as part of our wider Game On Scotland programme. Fallin was a host community for our Game On Camps, with a week-long programme as part of CRT's 25th Anniversary activity schedule. These sessions form part of our free football and physical activity offer for children and young people, designed to boost wellbeing, confidence and community participation.
