Our English for Speakers of Other Languages courses can help you to improve your English to help you get a job, understand your doctor, help your children at school and enjoy life in the UK.

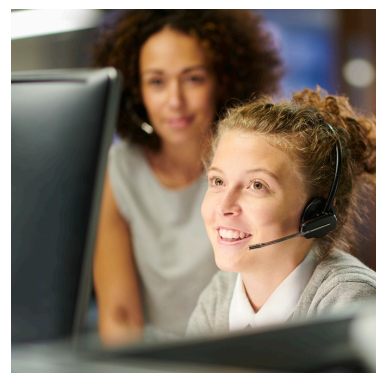
